

201: Physician Engagement

This course will explore key aspects of physician engagement and how successful engagement serves as a critical pillar to improving quality, creating value and "returning the joy to work" within health care delivery systems. Rather than approaching engagement through the transactional lens of "managing physicians", attendees will gain an appreciation of alternative strategies and approaches to enhance provider engagement, team function and alignment.

202: Critical Coaching and Mentoring, Strategic Planning and Advocacy and Influence

Physician leaders must engage with every level of staff within the organization. This session will provide physicians with the skills to better understand human behavior, manage conflicts, and effectively give and receive feedback to improve the overall performance and culture of the organization. 203: Healthcare Finance for Physicians: Financial Analysis Making Business Decisions with Numbers

Building upon the 2022 Healthcare Finance for Physicians PLA 100 program, participants in this program will tackle a series of micro cases based on real-world situations. 204: Just Culture and Human Factors

A just culture helps create an environment where individuals feel free to report errors and help the organization to learn from mistakes. Building upon the 2022 Physicians PLA 100 program introduction to Human Factors, participants will explore the human factor processes that support human strengths and mitigate human weaknesses that lead to errors.
